Antibody is produced by immunizing animals with a synthetic peptide at the sequence of human Ezrin

Storage buffer and conditions:

Antibody store in 10 mM PBS, 0.5mg/ml BSA, 50% glycerol (buffer) .

Shipped at 4°C. Store at-20°C or -80°C.

Tissue specificity:

Expressed in cerebral cortex, basal ganglia, hippocampus, hypophysis, and optic nerve. Weakly expressed in brain stem and diencephalon. Stronger expression was detected in gray matter of frontal lobe

Apical cell membrane, Peripheral membrane protein, Cytoplasmic side. Cell projection. Cell projection, microvillus membrane, Peripheral membrane protein, Cytoplasmic side. Cell projection, ruffle

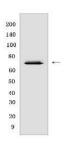

Probably involved in connections of major cytoskeletal structures to the plasma membrane. In epithelial cells, required for the formation of microvilli and membrane ruffles on the apical pole. Along with PLEKHG6, required for normal macropinocytosis..
