Antibody is produced by immunizing animals with a synthetic peptide of human Alpha Fodrin.

Storage buffer and conditions:

Antibody store in 10 mM PBS, 0.5mg/ml BSA, 50% glycerol (buffer) .

Shipped at 4°C. Store at-20°C or -80°C.

Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton. Cytoplasm, cell cortex.

Function:

Fodrin, which seems to be involved in secretion, interacts with calmodulin in a calcium-dependent manner and is thus candidate for the calcium-dependent movement of the cytoskeleton at the membrane.

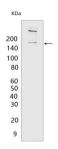
